

## **Patient case: Knee prosthesis operated patient, swelling and hematoma**

Patient: approximately 50 year-old knee prosthesis operated female

Treatment description: The patient was operated two days earlier. Central treatment, thereafter left supraclavicular fossa region, shoulder line, and back continued down along the spine to the lower back. Careful treatment of the groin area and medial side of the knee.

Treatment result: Less swelling and feeling of pressure after a 20 minute treatment. The hematoma moved from its place, range of motion was increased and patient had no complications. After the treatment the patient no longer felt pain or had massive limitations in the range of motion, and the active physiotherapy could be started.



Before the treatment. Patient's metabolism has weakened. Inflammation is clearly visible in the wound area. Massive hematoma.



20 min. after the treatment. The bruise has moved from its place and the metabolism has clearly increased.
