

Patient case: Operated knee with swelling and pain

Patient: approximately 50 year-old woman

Description: Patient's knee has been operated twice during the last ten years. Latest operation was done ca. three years ago. During the last couple of months she has suffered from pain and massive swelling. The patient was treated once with the LymphaTouch device following the 20 minute treatment protocol.

Treatment result: The swelling was significantly reduced and flexion increased by several degrees. After the treatment the patient was not drinking enough fluids which resulted as headache and malaise. These symptoms did not last long.

The pain on the knee was reduced 8 > 2 in the VAS pain scale. The pain and swelling were gone.

After the pain and swelling had significantly reduced, the flexion was improved by several degrees.
