

Case report: Post-mastectomy lymphoedema in the lower arm

Patient: *Patient is a 40-year-old woman, who has been operated for breast cancer five years earlier. Active cancer treatments have been completed, but as a result of the surgery, the patient suffers from lymphoedema in the lower arm. She has received treatment for the condition for several years in the form of manual lymphatic drainage and compression sleeves.*

Methods: Patient was treated twice using the LymphaTouch device.

Results: The treatment results already after two treatments with the LymphaTouch were clearly better than with the earlier manual therapy, for instance the fibrotic tissue got softer. The patient's feelings about the therapy were also positive.
